They will get an education on hunting, conservation and safety in the outdoors. They will be connected with a group of young hunters who share similar passions and a year membership to Young Guns of SCI.

## Award Criteria:

1. Nominee/ applicant must reside in the Four Corners area and have a legal driver's license and no felonies (18-25).
2. Nominee/ applicant must consent to the nomination.
3. Nominee/ applicant must be a citizen of the United States.
4. Nominee/ applicant must be willing to be interviewed by a Director over the phone
5. Nominee/ applicant must be willing to have pictures/ video of them
6. Nominee/ applicant must disclose any prior hunting or shooting experience.

**Deadline** for the nominations is January 31st.

**Announcement** of the recipient will be made at the Chapter's annual fundraiser, March 9.

## Special Provisions:

- Hunt will be donated to the awarded nominee/applicant. This hunt will be determined after applications are submitted. It may be a big game hunt or a bird hunt. We can assist in getting the recipient hunter's education, proper range safety training, and the appropriate firearm.
